

# Make a Rain Gauge

## What you need:

- a straight-sided clean glass jar with a wide mouth
- ruler pattern
- clear contact paper
- scissors
- clear tape

## What you do:

1. Cut out the ruler pattern.
2. Cover it with clear contact paper on both sides, pressing tightly with enough edge on all sides to seal.
3. Tape the ruler securely on the outside of the jar, flush with the bottom.
4. Place your rain gauge outside in an open place, secured from wind with rocks around the base.
