

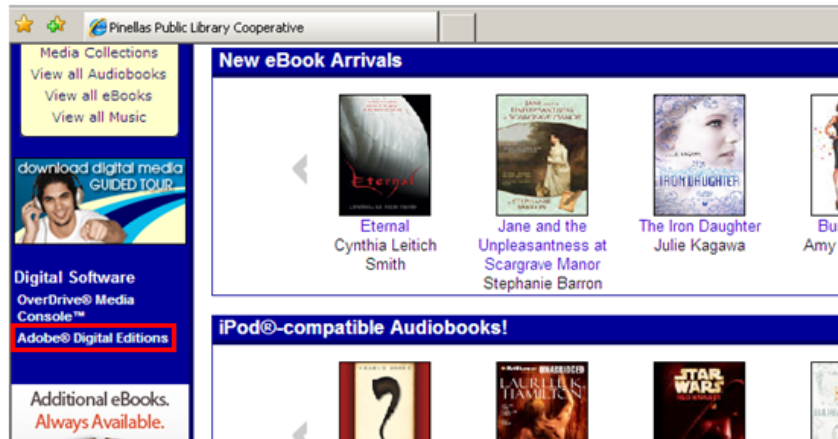
## Clearwater Public Library System Presents... Transferring E-books to Your Nook

*This tutorial will teach you how to find, checkout, and transfer e-books from our digital catalog to your Nook.*

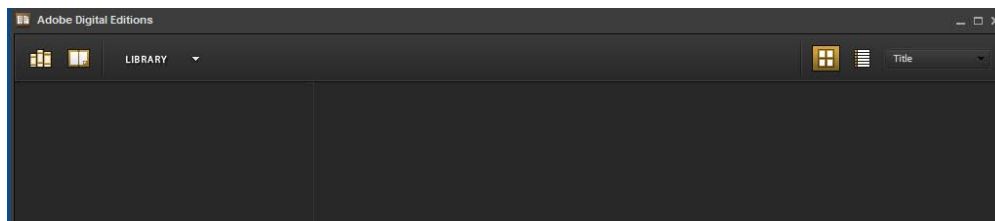
- Go to the library's homepage: [www.myclearwater.com/CPL](http://www.myclearwater.com/CPL) . Click on the OverDrive icon. Sign in by clicking on the 'Sign in' link at the top of the page.



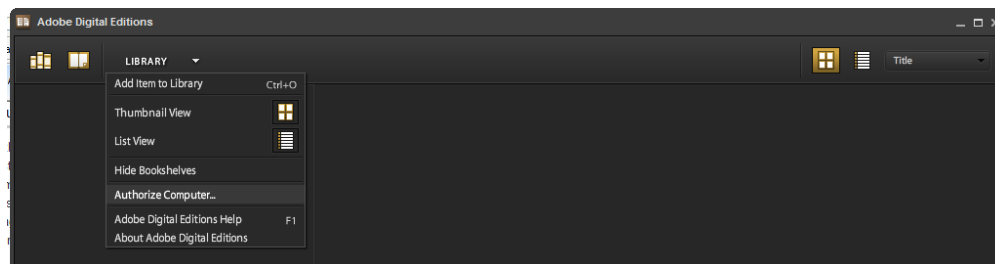
- You will need Adobe Digital Editions on your computer. This program transfers your e-books to your Nook. Click on 'Adobe Digital Editions' from the left-hand menu. Click on the button that says 'Get Adobe Digital Editions.' This will bring up a new window. Click on 'Install.' Follow the directions.



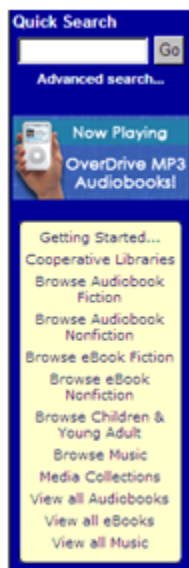
- You also need to create an Adobe account. You have to use it to ‘authorize your computer’ so you can read your e-book. You can go to <https://www.adobe.com/cfusion/membership/> to register for an account.
- This is what Adobe Digital Editions looks like when it is first opened.



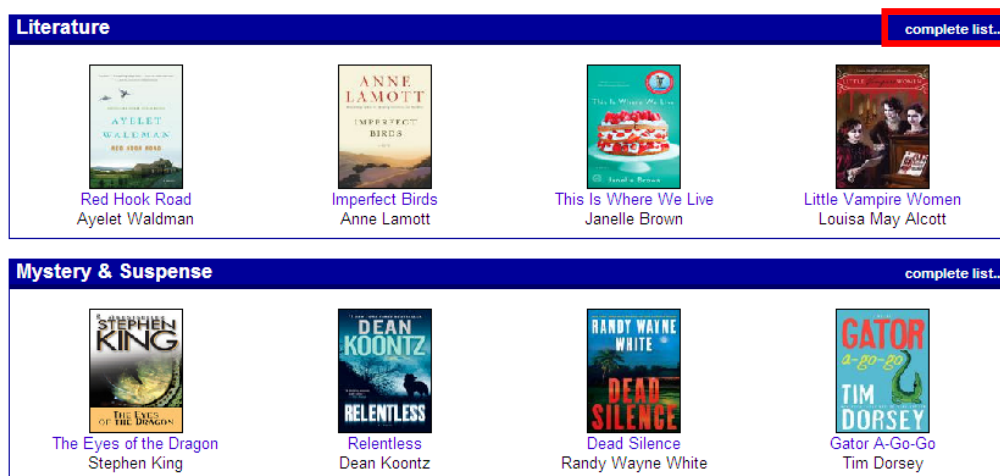
- This is the ‘Library’ menu. Clicking on ‘Authorize Computer’ will allow you to sign in using your Adobe account. You can do this now or when you attach your Nook.



- Go back to the catalog. You can search the catalog or sort the catalog by format. You can type a title, author name, subject, etc. into the ‘Quick Search’ bar then click ‘Go.’ This will search the catalog for you. You may also browse by format. Clicking ‘Browse e-Book Fiction’ will allow you to see all fiction e-books that the library has.



- Clicking on the one of the formats will bring up a list of genres. You can look at specific genres to make your browsing easier. Click 'Complete List' to see all of the e-books in that genre. You may also type keywords into the quick search bar on the left side of the screen. This will work like the search bar you find in the PPLC catalog.



- You may sort the e-books by title, creator, release date, most popular, and date added to site. Click 'Title' to sort by title etc. You can also search within the results. Do this by typing your new keywords in the box and clicking 'Submit.' You may also have the catalog only display titles that are available. This means that it will only show titles that you may check out

instantly. To do this, check the box next to the option to show titles with copies available. Click the 'Submit' button to show your new results list.

- You should log in before you start searching for e-books. It makes it easier once you try to checkout. You only need your library card number to sign in.

- Always check to make the e-material is compatible with the Nook. The Nook supports several formats for its e-materials. All versions of the Nook support four of the five e-book formats. They support EPUB, Open EPUB, PDF, and Open PDF. The only format it does not support is the Kindle format. You can identify the book formats available with the icons below.



- The Nook 1<sup>st</sup> Edition and the NookColor support some audiobooks in mp3 format. You can identify the format available with the icon below.



- Now you need to check if the title is available. The library has a certain number of licenses for a given work. Only one person may use a license at a time. This means that e-books may not be available for download. Each record shows the number of available copies for each e-material. If the e-book is not available, you may add yourself to the waiting list. Click 'Join the Waiting List.' This will bring up a form. Fill out the form and click on 'Join the Waiting List.' This will add you to the waiting list for the e-book.

No one can check out the e-material while it is in your cart. Your cart will expire after sixty minutes. Your cart will automatically come up when you click 'Add to Cart.'

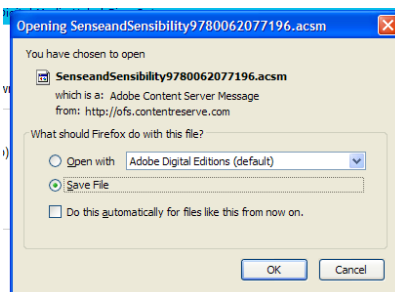
- This is the download page. Click on the 'Download' button to download the e-book to your computer. Once it is on the computer, you can use Adobe Digital Editions to move it to your Nook.

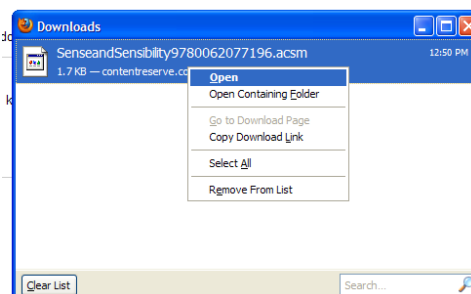

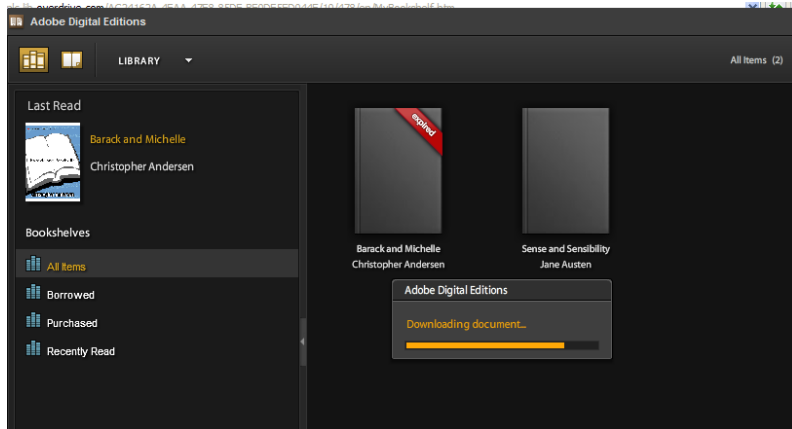
- A box will come up on the screen. Select 'Save File.' Press 'OK.' This will download the file.



- This window shows your current downloads. Once your download is complete, right-click on the file name to open a menu. Select 'Open' from that menu.



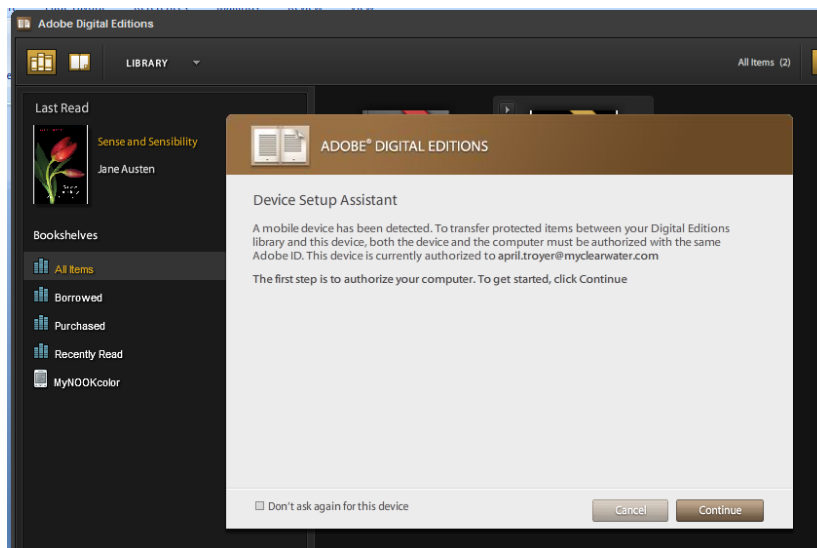
- Adobe will begin moving the e-book into its library.



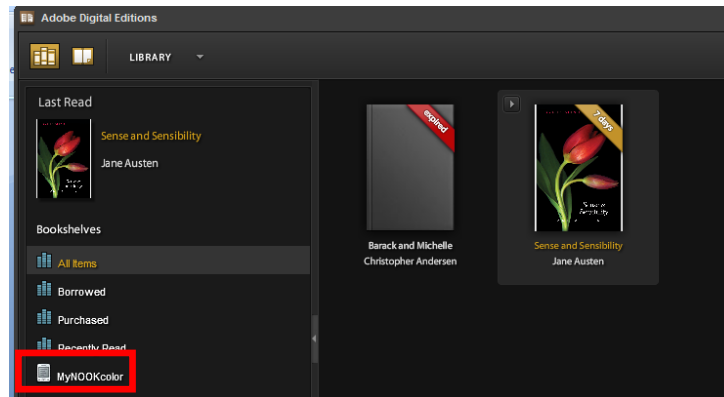
- Attach the Nook to the computer now. Use the cable that came with the Nook. The smaller end attaches to the Nook. The larger end goes into the computer. The 'N' on the cable should face upward.



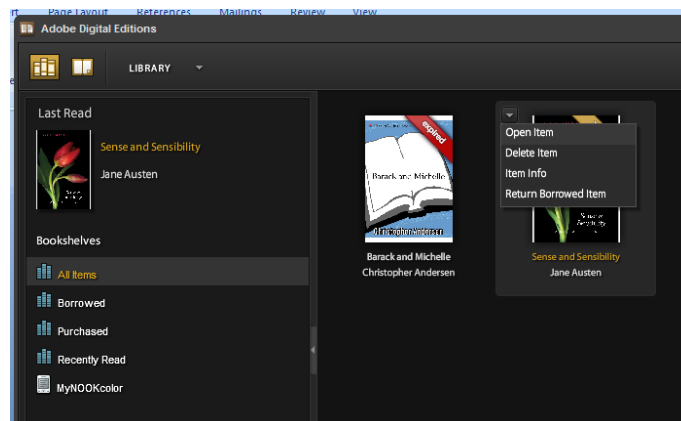
- This screen will appear when you attach the Nook. It will take you through the steps to authorize the computer.



- Your device will now show up in Adobe Digital Editions. Click on the name to see what materials you have on the Nook.



- Click on the triangle on the upper left corner of the cover. This is where you can return the e-book to the library. Returning the e-book before it expires will allow you to check out more e-books.



- Click and hold the cover you want to move to the Nook. Drag it to your Nook.
