- Currently constructing three stormwater/ environmental recreation projects: Glen Oaks, Kapok Wetlands and Flood Plain Restoration, and Lake Bellevue Improvements.
- Continuing traffic calming program, currently implementing project in North Greenwood and completing design for Skycrest.
- Continuing expansion of reclaimed water system in Drew/Union and Sunset/Seville areas.

- Continued expansion of the city's trail system with pedestrian bridges under construction on McMullen Booth Road at Drew Street and on Mandalay Channel at Clearwater Beach. Completed design of East-West Trail extension along Druid Road.
- Improved traffic flow on Gulf-to-Bay Boulevard with intersection improvements at Bayshore Boulevard and Damascus Road.
- Scheduled to begin construction in 2005 on the BeachWalk project, which will transform south Clearwater Beach into a beautiful pedestrian-oriented destination.

Completion of the new Memorial Causeway Bridge is scheduled for late 2005.
