

**Outreach.** The Police Department strengthened its community outreach capabilities through safety fairs and awards for kids to go to recreation centers.

**Ordinances.** Several citywide ordinances help protect the people and property of Clearwater, and the Community Response Team enforces these rules. The Public Arts Ordinance was approved by the City Council and promotes the arts.

**Outsourcing.** The City looks at outsourcing where possible. The Library System completed planning and training for outsourcing of materials cataloging and processing.

**Officers.** The Police Department employs 260 sworn officers that help keep Clearwater

safe.

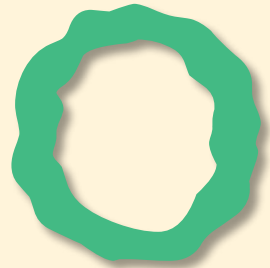
**Occupational Licenses.**

Occupational Licenses are now called Business Tax Receipts as mandated by state statutes.

**Official Records.** This year, the department launched a new digital agenda and records management system that makes public records more accessible to residents and business owners.
