☀ **Waterways.** The Marine and Aviation Department is creating a Waterway Management Plan – a compilation of ordinances, boat traffic usage patterns, and general descriptions of the channels and land sites in Clearwater Harbor. The plan will set standards to determine feasibility of wake zones, water usage, and density of boating traffic.

☀ **Workers Compensation.** City employees filed 184 workers compensation claims in fiscal year 2006, a decrease of approximately 20% from the last fiscal year's total.

☀ **Workforce.** Clearwater employs a diverse working staff to fully serve the residents of Clearwater. The city invests in training and technology to ensure that the workforce continues to stay on top of the latest developments within their fields.

☀ **Wheelchairs.** The Equity Services Department ensures that all city facilities comply with ADA requirements regarding wheelchairs. Children of all abilities can play together at the Long Center's Limitless Playground, which is wheelchair accessible.
