The award is valid for a period of one year only. We believe our current budget continues to conform to program requirements, and we are submitting it to GFOA to determine its eligibility for another award.

The GFOA is the leading association for government finance professionals in North America. This is our nineteenth year to win the award; it was given for our Annual Operating and Capital Improvement Budget 2004/2005. GFOA's Distinguished Budget Presentation Awards Program is the only national awards program in governmental budgeting. The City also holds GFOA's Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting for our Comprehensive Annual Financial Report.
