Cleveland Street Parking Limits Extended from One to Two Hours

CLEARWATER, Fla. - Beginning Nov. 1, the one-hour metered parking on Cleveland Street from the waterfront to East Avenue will be increased to two hours. The 30-minute metered parking in the high demand areas of the same stretch will not be affected.

The adjustment to two hours will be evaluated after six months to determine how well it is working. The goal is to make it easier for customers and patrons to frequent restaurants along Cleveland Street.

"The city is making this change as more restaurants are opening on Cleveland Street with a greater demand for more than one-hour parking," said Rod Irwin, Clearwater's Assistant City Manager. "Allowing vehicles to park for two hours instead of one hopefully will encourage residents and visitors to dine in downtown without being concerned about an expired meter."

Patrons looking for long-term parking options should use off-street parking or the Garden Avenue or Station Square parking garages.
