NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following addendum serves to provide clarification and to answer the questions received on ITB # 25-23, Ductile Iron Pipes, Fittings, Mechanical Joint Restraints and Polyethylene Tubing

<u>Question 1</u>: Specifications – D - VI - will the City consider ADS as an acceptable manufacturer for polyethylene tubing?

<u>Answer to Question 1:</u> The City of Clearwater accepts ADS as an acceptable manufacturer for polyethylene tubing.

<u>Question 2</u>: Milestones – 4) Prices: The PPI is still not an accurate indicator of increases incurred as a result of global supply chain constrictions, workforce challenges, increased labor costs, raw materials and transportation/freight uncertainty. Would the City consider accepting increase letters from the specific manufacturers providing said materials ?

<u>Answer to Question 2:</u> Prices are based on the PPI for ductile iron pressure pipe and fittings. Any exceptions to our terms must be stated on the EXCEPTIONS/ADDITIONAL MATERIALS/ADDENDA form, page 28 of the solicitation in order to be considered.

<u>Question 3</u>: Can you also verify that all of the ductile iron fittings in Group 1 are to be cement lined for water/reclaim applications ?

<u>Answer to Question 3:</u> Yes, Cement-Mortar Interior Lining (Portable and Reclaimed Water) please reference DETAILED SPECIFICATIONS 3, SPECIFICATIONS, A and B, II. Coating and Lining, pages 16-17.
