Pre-Qualification https://www.myclearwater.com/government/city-departments/finance-budget/doing-business-with-the-city/bid-information/construction-management In order to be eligible to bid for this project, the contractor/bidder must be pre-qualified with the Engineering Department's Construction Division in the Water/bid-information/construction-management In order to be eligible to bid eligible with the Engineering Department's Construction Mains category with a minimum amount of \$4,000,000.00 (Four Million). It is the Contractor's/Bidder's responsibility to confirm pre-qualification eligibility prior to submitting a bid. 13. <u>Scope of Work</u> – The Reclaimed Water Piping Improvements Project (21-0029-UT) shall be performed in accordance with the Contract Documents and generally includes, but is not limited to, the following:

Provision and installation of various sizes of reclaimed water (RCW) main installations including: 4-inch and 8-inch HDPE Reclaimed Water main via HDD; 4-inch, 6-inch, and 8-inch PVC Reclaimed Water main via open cut; and 8-inch and 16-inch Ductile Iron Reclaimed Water Main via open cut, and 2-inch polyethylene RCW service line in casing via HDD (~5,200 LF)

Various size gate valve replacements across the City service area including 4", 6", 8", 12", 16", and 20" gate valves and service line replacements in the North Clearwater Beach area (approximately 983 service lines).

Removal and replacement of 8-inch VCP gravity main adjacent to RCW main installation

Manhole replacement

Lateral replacement and reconnection and associated appurtenances.

Contract Period: 365 days from the date reflected in the Notice to Proceed.
